#### ACADEMIC RESULTS

The reputation of an educational institution is based largely upon the performance of its students. I am pleased to report that we have recorded above 92% result in B.A. Prog./ B.A.(H) Hindi I Year / B.A. (H) English II Year, 95% result in B.A.(H) Political Science I Year / B.Com (H) II Year, 93% result in B.Com (Prog.) I Year and 90% result in B.Com. (H) I year. 91% result in B.A.(H) Hindi II year, 84% result in B.A. (H) Economics II year, 83.67% in Economics I Year, 97.89% result in Political Science II Year, 95% result in B.Com (H) II Year.

#### INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE

Following our past tradition of holding National Seminars / Conferences, the college organized a National Conference [the thirteenth in succession] on the theme, 'Role and Contribution of Renewable Energy in Climate Change Mitigation" under the Convenership of **Dr. S. P. Sharma.** The Conference was organized at Indian Institute of Public Administration, Delhi on February 11-12, 2016.
