

NAAC

The College had the NAAC Peer Team visit on 22nd and 23rd September, 2017 for the first cycle of assessment and accreditation for which I acknowledge the tremendous amount of hard-work put up by all my Colleagues and students led by the NAAC Steering Committee Coordinator Dr. Aditya P. Tripathi and two Co-coordinators Dr. S.P. Sharma and Dr. Pramod Kumar.

Here, I wish to share that the College has been successful in achieving B+ Grade.



ACADEMIC RESULTS

The reputation of an educational institution is based largely upon the performance of its students. I am pleased to report that we have recorded 100% result in B.A. (H) Hindi II Year, 98.45% result in B.Com. Prog. II Year, 96% result in B.A.(H) Political Science III Year & B.Com. I Year, 95% result in B.A. Prog./ B.A.(H) Economics / Political Science I & II Year & B.Com. (H) I Year, 93% result in B.A. Prog. & B.A. (H) Economics III Year & B.Com. III Year, 92% result in B.Com. (H) III Year, 91% result in B.A.Prog. I Year, 89% result in B.A.(H) Hindi I Year, 85.71% result in B.Com. (H) II Year, 84% result in B.A.(H) Economics I Year & B.A. (H) Hindi III Year.

INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC)

The education today essentially requires the interaction of students and faculty members with eminent personalities in the field of academics and corporate world on the pertinent issues and emerging dimensions of the subject (s) for augmentation of their knowledge. In order to ensure the holistic development of all concerned, our college is having an active cell viz; Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) to ensure the quality in every functioning of the institution related to all stakeholders including Students, Faculty Members and Non-Teaching Staff of the College.

In its ongoing pursuit of ensuring quality at institutional level, IQAC under the Chairmanship of Dr. Pravin Kumar, Principal, SLC-E, organised various programmes in the college which included Live Lectures of eminent Speakers from abroad, Awareness programmes on emerging issues, Quality Improvement Programmes (Q.I.P.), Seminars, Orientation Programmes, Student Knowledge Sharing Programme (SKSP) and Faculty Development Programmes. The details of event (s) organised by IQAC are as follows:

- IQAC organized an Awareness Programme on Goods & Services Tax (GST) on **August 2nd 2017**. CA Manish Dubey and CA Rishi Mohna Rastogi were the resource persons. The programme included practical knowledge of GST including invoice generation, filing of returns, dealing with penalties along with the theoretical inputs. It was very much appreciated by faculty members as well as students.
- In its pursuit to ensure the holistic development of stakeholders, IQAC organized a Quality Improvement Programme (QIP) for **Non-Teaching Staff** of the college on 'Purchase Management & e-Procurement' by **Shri B. Dhanesh , Deputy Director, Institute of Secretariat Training & Management (IST&M), Dept. of Personnel & Training (DoPT) , Govt. of India, New Delhi** on August 5th, 2017. The programme intended to ensure a better and clear understanding of GFR (2017) and implementation of e-Procurement policy including registration of the government institutions, understanding functionalities of GeM etc. The



Program was attended not only by the staff of our college but it also had representation from other colleges of University of Delhi.

- A Quality Improvement Programme for **Faculty Members, Students & Staff** on '**Total Quality Person**' (TQP) was organized on August 8th, 2017. QIP was conducted by **Professor (Dr.) C.V.Ramanan**, Inspirational Speaker & Life Coach, Director Center for Joy @ Work, INMANTEC, a Spiritual Sadhak, Chief Mentor and Happiness Officer at Prudentia Group LLC, **having 36 Years of Experience** into Corporate, Academic, Teaching & Training. Programme included 30 odd moving stories each with a lesson of life, around 10 games with take-homes, slice-of-life examples, assignment and cases besides fun and humor. Invariably, there was some laughter, tears and great feelings. Most of the participants found TQP workshop mesmerizing and riveting, soul-stirring and life changing. Some of the participants said that, '**It was the best thing they have heard and experienced in their lives**'.
- Internal Quality Assurance Cell in collaboration with various departments including Commerce, Computer Science, Economics, English, Hindi, History, Mathematics and Political science organized one day Seminar on contemporary themes. The seminars were well attended and appreciated by the Students, faculty Members & Research Scholars.
- Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) in Collaboration with the Placement Cell of the college and T.I.M.E. Education conducted an Orientation programme on '**Campus Recruitment Training**' (CRT) Programme by **Shri Ankur Jain, Chief Knowledge Expert-T.I.M.E.** on August 18th, 2017. INFRASTRUCTURE

Revamping infrastructure is an ongoing process. Furthermore, to report during this academic year, the following infrastructure facilities are added:

- The College has refurnished and revamped the Conference Hall with state of the art facilities.
- The College is in the process of constructing lift and staircase for which work is in process.
- The College proudly announces that it has constructed a state-of-the-art Reading Room with huge seating capacity.
- Overhead water tank with the capacity of 50,000 litre is likely to be functional very soon and will cater to the future water demands of the college.
- The College has also introduced an important designated facility for the PwD students of the College in the form of PwD Facilitation Centre which has dedicated computer systems with all the relevant software installed so as to facilitate the smooth imparting of education to PwD students.
- The College has also constructed a reading room for faculty to promote research aptitude among the teachers.
- The Seminar Room on the ground floor in the new building has also been refurnished.
- The College has also constructed an Amphitheatre across the College Canteen for the benefit of the students.
- Shyam Lal College now has an AC furnished canteen and Bank with ATM.
- Office layout has also been changed to improve the functioning of the administration.

ACADEMIC PRIZES & SCHOLARSHIPS

Academic Prizes are awarded to the students on the basis of their results in the annual examinations by the college at the annual function. In addition to this, following memorial cash prizes are also awarded: -

- Shri Sunder Lal Rohatgi & Smt. Roopwati Rohatgi Memorial Prizes: Three prizes of Rs.250/- each to be awarded annually to the toppers of final year students of B.Com (H), B.Com and B.A. Programme. These



prizes were instituted by Late Sh. B.B. Rohatgi in the fond memory of his parents.

- Km. Kanika Gupta Memorial Prizes: The prizes are of the value of Rs.250/- each given to the students securing highest marks in B.Com (Hons.) I and II year examinations. These prizes are instituted by Dr. R.L. Gupta of the Department of Commerce, in the loving memory of his daughter, Km. Kanika Gupta.
- Vice Chancellor's financial Assistance: The Financial Assistance is awarded to those students whose family income from all sources is less than 1 Lac per annum and having APL and BPL valid ration cards issued from the competent authority.
- Shyam Lal Gupta Memorial Prize: A prize of Rs.11,000/- has been instituted by Shyamlal Charitable Trust in the memory of Late Padam Shri Shyamlal Gupta, the Founder of the College. This prize is given to the student who secures the highest percentage of marks in the First / Second year of any course.
- Other Delhi University Awards and Financial Assistance: There are many Awards/ Financial Assistance / Scholarship schemes which are declared by the University from time to time.
- This year, the Students' Union of the College under Advisorship of Dr. Aditya P. Tripathi has instituted a scholarship with an endowment fund of Rs.25,000/-. Cash Prize out of this fund will be given to a student scoring highest percentage of marks in aggregate from any discipline / course.

Our library is automated and ensures the availability of current titles by consulting publishers', catalogue, book reviews and publisher websites. Open access facilities to students and staff are available on ground floor and upper library building.

The library is computerized with bar coded books and membership cards. Xerox facility is also available for the staff members. The existing ceiling of the number of copies of a title to be purchased has been increased from five to twenty in view of new syllabi. The new arrivals are duly notified and prominently displayed.
