### ACADEMIC RESULTS

The reputation of an educational institution is based largely upon the performance of its students. I am pleased to report that we have recorded 80.22%, 81.14% & 95.26% result in B.Com. I, II & III Year respectively, 80%, 81.81% & 87.50% result in B.Com.(H) I, II & III Year respectively, 92.30%, 97.72% & 97.56% result in B.A. (H) Political Science I, II & III Year respectively, 72.72%, 72.72% & 87.80% result in B.A. (H) Economics I, II & III Year respectively, 96.36%, 78.04% & 85.71% result in B.A. (H) Hindi I, II & III Year respectively, 78.21%, 84.84% & 74.03% result in B.A. Prog. I, II & III Year respectively.
