# **Opening Ceremony**





#### Session 2: Women's Empowerment in Entrepreneurship




#### Speaker: Dr. Nisha Devi


The first day concluded with a vote of thanks by Dr. Manu Umesh, who appreciated the speakers for their valuable insights. The audience left feeling empowered and inspired.
















**Selection of Best Speakers**










# **Felicitation Ceremony:**
