Report on Poster-Making and Essay-Writing Competitions for the College Magazine


On **5th March 2025**, the Magazine Committee successfully organized two creative competitions – the Poster-Making Competition and the Essay-Writing Competition – as part of the preparations for the upcoming issue of the college magazine.
